Course Tear-Down -

Classes: All Wheel Drive (AWD)
2 Wheel Front (2WF)
2 Wheel Rear (2WR)

Tires: Studded tires are **not** allowed

Number of Entries: 20 maximum

Since this event is scheduled around (before and between) the running of the Super Special Stages of the Sno*Drift Rally, times may vary in order to keep the rally running on time. Competitors are required to help with the course set-up and tear-down and with crowd control and marshaling during the running of the Super Special Stages.

Cars must meet safety standards of any SCCA rallycross competition and must pass a tech inspection before competing. A co-driver is allowed.

Since there is a limit of 20 entries, preference will be given to those competitors who sign-up and work the Sno*Drift Rally on Friday, January 30, 2009. You may register online at www.sno-drift.org. Please be sure to indicate that you will be running the Sno-X on Saturday.

The Sno*Drift Rally committee reserves the right to refuse an entry for any reason.

Trophies will be presented at the end of the Sno-X event. Competitors are also welcome to attend the Sno*Drift Awards ceremony at the Hillman Community Center, Hillman, Michigan.
