Competitor Bulletin #1

1. Competitors who are entered in SNO*ATTACK must carry Organizer supplied decals on each side of the car during the rally. These decals are to be placed on the front doors behind the number backers and just above the class designator (see diagram below).
2. Competitors who are registered for the Greer Enterprises Nokian Tyre contingency awards must carry Organizer supplied decals on each side of the car during the rally. These decals are to be placed high on the front fenders just forward of the front edge of the door (see diagram below).



3. Maximum score for each running of the Super Specials (SS 13 & SS 14) shall be bogey time (4 min.).
4. Service crews who wish to park their trailers in the St Augustine lot at the end of the rally (Supp. Regs. 12.5) must use the upper lot at the rear of the church. Do not interfere with evening Mass.





5. We wish to assure a favorable fan experience at our Parcs Expose. All cars must be in Friday Parc Expose by 2:00 PM. Attendance by all drivers and co-drivers at the Saturday Parc Expose is mandatory. Cars and competitors must be in Saturday Parc Expose by 8:00 AM. Penalty is \$100, assessed against each vehicle and EACH absent individual.
6. Tim and Melissa Jackson (Car #817) are unable to compete this year. They have a heated garage in Lewiston that they have graciously offered to any competitor who needs to perform overnight repairs during Sno*Drift. Their phone number will be posted on the official notice board.
7. The descriptions of Atlanta service area allocations are not correct (Supp. Regs. 3.3). The actual sizes are 15' x 35' (525 sq. ft.) rather than 20' x 25' (500 sq. ft.) Oversize service sizes are 30' x 55' (1650 sq. ft.) rather than 35' x 50' (1750 sq. ft.).
8. Once again, several local businesses have shown their support for Sno*Drift by offering prizes for several special stages. Be sure to thank these sponsors should you see them during the rally.

10.2. The starting list will be posted as soon as possible after the close of registration. The list will be posted on the Official Notice Board and at the Rally America truck in Lewiston no later than 1:00 PM on Friday, January 29, 2010. The restart list will be posted at the Saturday Parc Expose and at the Rally America truck at the Atlanta School not later than 7:30 AM on Saturday, January 30, 2010. NO CHANGES WILL BE MADE TO THE START ORDER AFTER 1:30 PM ON FRIDAY OR 800 AM ON SATURDAY.
