

The Sno*Drift Rally returns to Montmorency County on January 29 – 30, 2010. The Friday stages center around service in Lewiston, while the Saturday stages are headquartered in Atlanta. The rally ends at the Community Center in Hillman on Saturday night. Watch for the “Spectator Guide” in the Montmorency Tribune during the week before the race to get directions to all the stages.

The Sno*Drift Rally Super Special will be run twice at Lewiston Sand and Gravel beginning about 1:30 PM on Saturday, January 30, 2010. There will be a \$5.00 entry fee for all spectators (children under 12 are free). The entry fee includes free bus transportation from either Lewiston or Atlanta. The stage is approximately 0.7 miles and the best viewing is a few steps from the bus drop-off point.

The Atlanta buses will run every 15 minutes beginning at 12:00 Noon from the new Atlanta High School on County Road 489 South of Atlanta. Parking is available in the lot directly across the street from the high school and this is where the buses will leave from. There is additional parking available on the West side of the high school.

The Lewiston buses will run continuously from the Ace Hardware parking lot at the Northwest corner of County Roads 612 and 489. Buses will begin running from here around 12:15 PM.

The Super Special will have extremely limited parking onsite at \$10.00 per car plus admission, and no parking on Buttles Road, so your best bet is to take the bus. There will also be a warming tent and refreshments available in the spectator area. Proceeds from the refreshment sales benefit the American Cancer Society’s Relay for Life.
